#### The Fairway Foundation's Zero-Tolerance Stance Against Abuse

The Fairway Foundation has a great deal of concern about the safety and abuse of children. As a person who is interested in the well being of children, we believe you are entitled to know how our organization is combating this critical issue. In addition, as an applicant for a volunteer/staff position with our organization, you need to know the defensive measures we employ to protect children participating in our programs, as well as the volunteer/staff from this serious problem.

We will not tolerate the abuse of any child. We are aware that some people apply for positions in the youth services field because they are interested in children sexually. We make an active and, we believe, effective effort to prevent child abuse in our programs. We attempt to screen out molesters through a careful background check. We structure our activities by recommending that volunteer/staff not be left alone with children. We periodically interview children about their experiences in our program, and encourage open discussion of their problems. We take any allegations by children and by others very seriously, and refer all allegations to the local or state law enforcement authorities for investigation in which we fully cooperate.

The Fairway Foundation takes a Zero-Tolerance stance against abuse of children or any participant in our programs. In addition, the safeguards built into our activities protect our volunteers and staff from placing themselves in situations that might be misinterpreted by children and others.
